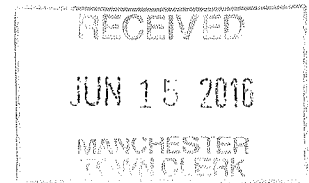


**LEGAL NOTICE  
TOWN OF MANCHESTER  
NOTICE OF THE COLLECTOR OF REVENUE**



The Assistant Collector of Revenue of the Town of Manchester is giving notice that the first installment of taxes on the Grand List of October 1, 2015 becomes due and payable on July 1, 2016. Real Estate and Personal Property taxes of less than \$400.00 shall be due and payable in one installment on July 1, 2016. All Motor Vehicle taxes shall be due and payable in one installment on July 1, 2016.

Taxes must be paid on or before August 1, 2016 to avoid interest charges. Taxes will become delinquent on August 2, 2016. As soon as such tax becomes delinquent, it shall be subject to interest at the rate of 1 1/2% of such tax for each month or fraction thereof which elapses from the time when such tax becomes due and payable (July 1) until the same is paid. Minimum interest is \$2.00.

**FAILURE TO RECEIVE A TAX BILL SHALL NOT INVALIDATE THE TAX OR INTEREST CHARGES.**

**AVOID WAITING IN LONG LINES. PLEASE RETURN YOUR PAYMENT BY MAIL.** If a receipt is desired, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope and all copies of the bill. Payment may also be made online at [www.townofmanchester.org](http://www.townofmanchester.org), a convenience fee applies for online payments.

The CT DMV and municipalities statewide are working to resolve some inconsistencies among residents' mailing addresses and domicile addresses. If you received a tax bill from a town that you did not reside in or garage your vehicle in as of October 1, 2015, contact the Assessor to request a transfer to the correct municipality. If your registration has expired or is due to expire with 60 days, and you have not received a renewal notification, you must contact DMV. If you are being reported with a tax (or other) compliance issue from a municipality you never lived in, you should contact the municipality reporting the compliance. You may renew your registration, cancel license plates and verify your renewal status at DMV's web site at: [www.ct.gov/dmv/online](http://www.ct.gov/dmv/online).

The Office of Assessment & Collection is located at 41 Center Street. The office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM. Extended hours until 6:00 PM on Monday, August 1, 2016.

The Town of Manchester Board of Assessment Appeals will hold a meeting on Saturday, September 10, 2016 at 8:30 AM at the Office of Assessment & Collection, at 41 Center Street. The purpose of this meeting is to conduct Motor Vehicle Assessment Appeal hearings for the Grand List of 2015.
