The second installment of taxes due on the Grand List of October 1, 2019 is due January 1, 2021. Failure to make payment on non-escrowed tax bills renders the tax delinquent on April 2, 2021. Interest will be charged at the rate of 1 1/2% per month from the due date, January 1. The minimum interest charge is \$2.00. Escrowed tax bills remain due by February 1, 2021, the final due date for all other tax bills is extended to April 1, 2021 pursuant to Executive Order 9R.

In compliance with Section 12-71b of the General Statutes, Motor Vehicle taxes due on the October 1, 2019 Supplemental Grand List are also due in full on January 1, 2021. These taxes are delinquent on April 2, 2021 and subject to the same interest.

FAILURE TO RECEIVE A TAX BILL SHALL NOT INVALIDATE THE TAX OR THE INTEREST CHARGES.

The Office of Assessment & Collection is located at 41 Center Street, Manchester. **Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, operations at the Office of Assessment & Collection could change with no notice.** Public access to the Manchester Town Hall is currently restricted and available by appointment only. To make an appointment to pay a tax bill, please call 806-647-3018 weekdays between 8:30 AM and 5:00 PM.

PLEASE CONSIDER RETURNING YOUR PAYMENT BY MAIL OR PAYING ONLINE, OR USING THE DROP BOX BEHIND TOWN HALL. If a receipt is desired, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope and all copies of the bill. Payment may also be made online at www.townofmanchester.org, a convenience fee applies for online real estate or personal property tax payments. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, for motor vehicle tax payments only, the Convenience fee will no longer be applied to motor vehicle credit or debit card payments and online payments until further notice.
